DIAGNOSIS. A blood gas sample is essential for determining CO intoxication, and the parameter of interest is carboxyhemoglobin. Carboxyhemoglobin is a measure of the carbon monoxide concentration in the red blood cells, but not the cellular levels of carbon monoxide in critical areas such as the brain and myocardium.
